### **JOB SUMMARY**

Casey Trees is looking for a motivated individual to work with its Design & Advocacy department to help determine the potential demand for conservation easements in the District and develop a potential action plan for implementing an easement program.

This fellowship is open to college graduates, graduate students or post graduate students with experience in land conservation or a related field.
