CASEY TREES AWARDED TD TREE DAYS GRANT TO ENHANCE WASHINGTON, DC'S TREE CANOPY

WASHINGTON, DC — October 29, 2004 – <u>TD Bank, America's Most Convenient Bank®</u> has selected Casey Trees to receive a 2024 TD Tree Days grant. Working with the Arbor Day Foundation, TD Tree Days is a community-based program that aims to grow green spaces and urban forests in primarily disadvantaged neighborhoods. The grant will allow Casey Trees' staff and volunteers to plant 58 trees at Mount Olivet Cemetery in Washington, DC on October 29, 2024.

They have been a committed partner in helping re-tree DC, sponsoring projects like this one each year and providing volunteers to plant a variety of tree species across the city. Planting at Mount Olivet Cemetery is especially impactful, as this space is not only hallowed ground for some, but also serves as public green space for all. Many people in the surrounding community visit to learn its history, walk their dogs, or simply take a walk and be among nature and trees."
